What are ICC profiles?

ICC (International Color Consortium) refers to a set of universal protocols adopted by several companies to ensure that color is described and interpreted accurately and consistently. These standards are supported by major applications such as Adobe Photoshop, Illustrator, Acrobat and InDesign, as well as monitors, scanners, digital cameras and other hardware devices sharing the same tool set.

After downloading our ICC profiles, you will need to use StuffIT (Mac) or WinZip (PC) to decompress the file.



To Install ICC profiles in Microsoft Windows 98/ME/2000/XP:

Download the profile to your desktop by right-clicking and selecting "Save Target As". Select the profile and right-click. A menu will pop up. Choose the "Install Profile" option. If the "Uninstall Profile" menu item appears, you already have an ICC profile of the same name installed.

To install ICC Profiles in Windows 95:

Download the profile to your desktop by right-clicking and selecting "Save Target As". Copy the ICC profile file to the WINDOWS\SYSTEM\COLOR directory.

To install ICC profiles in Windows NT 4.0:

Download the profile to your desktop by right-clicking and selecting "Save Target As". Copy the ICC profile to the WINNT\SYSTEM32\COLOR directory.

To install ICC profiles onto Mac with OS X:

You should install the profiles in one of two locations:

Copy the ICC profiles to the Users/[your login username]/Library/ColorSync/Profiles folder.

or

Copy the ICC profile files to the Library/ColorSync/Profiles folder.

Note: Installing in this location requires the user to be an administrator of this system.

To install ICC profiles onto a Mac with OS 8.x or 9.x:

Download the profile to your computer. Copy the ICC profile files to the ColorSync Profiles folder located in the System folder.

How to Apply them in Photoshop:

Once installed, open your image in Photoshop. Select Image/Adjust/Apply profile. Drop down menu will appear. Select the ICC profile of your choice and click apply.
